- You have a headache and a high fever, you feel shivery and you're aching all over. You are very weak.
- flu
- You have stomach ache and/or diarrhoea, and you feel sick. You may have eaten something wrong.
- food poisoning
- You cannot stop sneezing, your eyes are watering and you have an itchy throat.
- hay fever/you are allergic to something
- You have a nasty cough and a temperature, and your nose is blocked, which makes breathing difficult.
- a chest infection
- You have a temperature, your tonsils are swollen and sore. You can hardly swallow.
- tonsillitis

- an examination of something, especially a medical one to make sure that you are healthy
- a check-up (to go for/have a medical/dental/routine/thorough check-up)
- a blue, brown or purple mark that appears on the skin after somebody has fallen, been hit, etc.
- a bruise
- a metal device that is worn inside the mouth to help the teeth grow straight
- braces
- a sudden serious illness when a blood vessel (= tube) in the brain bursts or is blocked, which can cause death or the loss of the ability to move or to speak clearly
- a stroke
- an area of red spots on a person's skin, caused by an illness or a reaction to something
- a rash
- a hole in a tooth
- a cavity

- You are not feeling well, and you want some medical advice. The doctor will ask you some questions. Answer them with as many details as possible.
- **Doctor instructions**
- Ask the patient what the problem is, how long they have had it, and what they think caused it. Listen to their answers and suggest a treatment.
