# Grammar summary

## *Definite and indefinite articles*

### **Usage:**

- 1) There are definite and indefinite articles in English language.
- 2) Indefinite articles a /an we use for singular countable nouns, since we cannot leave them alone. We use a when the noun begins with consonant and an with vowels (be careful with pronunciation). We must not use a / an for uncountable nouns or plurals.
- 3) We can use the (the pronunciation also differs according to the beginning of the noun - consonant vs. vowels) for singular or plural nouns, countable or uncountable.  
Remember that some uncountable nouns, or plural countable nouns do not need definite article and we can use for example some instead of the.
- 4) We use a /an for: jobs, to say what kind of thing or person somebody or something is, to say „za“ in Czech (once a week etc.), when we first talk about something.
- 5) We use the for: when we think about specific thing or people, when it is clear which thing or person we mean, superlative adjectives, when there is only one thing of the kind, specific places and things like: the cinema, the theatre, the TV, the radio, musical instruments etc., when we talk about groups of people (the young etc.) , for nationalities, for countries with republic, states, kingdom etc., for oceans, seas, rivers, canals, deserts, mountain ranges, groups of islands, the north of....etc., hotels and restaurants, the .....of....., newspapers, organisations.
- 6) We do not use articles for plural countable and uncountable nouns when we speak about them in general. We do not use them for: bed, work, home, meals, when we say most, man = the human race, for names of places (cities, one-word countries etc.), lakes, mountains, streets, important buildings and institutions, companies and airlines.
- 7) Remember that there are many exceptions to these rules and sometimes you need to check it.
